Periods 5 SM3 Essentials

First remind student that they will have a benchmark test tomorrow. The best thing they can do is study their past tests to prepare. Also remind them that 3.4 is due on Tuesday. If they want to check their work, the key is in my big binder.

Today students will be working on lesson 3.5 Complex Zeros and Polynomials. Handout the worked out notes, note outline, and the homework (a text book page labeled 5.7). Students will spend the first 25 minutes on the notes by watching the "3.5 lecture video" on my website, going over their guided notes and transferring them to their outline. The rest of the time they should work on the homework listed at the bottom of the notes. The assignment is due Wednesday.

Period 6 Math Lab

This period is for students to work on Math homework. They may work in groups or pairs. When they finish their math homework they may work on homework for another class. If they have none, they may read a book. These are the only options. Make a special emphasis that students cannot have phones or any other electronic device. The only students that may have out laptops are Sis Rodriguez, Felicity Ringel, Aurora Abner, Benson Tullis, and Hughston Smith. If Felicity needs a laptop have her see Mrs. Smith. Hughston Smith may go work with Mrs. Smith during the period if he wants.

Period 7 & 8—Secondary Math 3

First ask students to turn in their homework (3.5) from Tuesday with a score out of 5. If they have questions, let them know they can check their work during homework time with the key I will leave in the big binder.

Pass out the take home quiz. Tell students their take home quiz is due on Wednesday by the end of the school day.

Today students will be learning how to graph polynomials. Handout the guided notes and the worked out examples. Watch the videos on my website "SM3 3.6 Lecture Video 1" and "SM3 3.6 Lecture Video 2".

After the video pass out the homework, it is a copy of a set of book pages. Then let students work on the assignment. It is due on Wednesday. They should work in groups of 2 or 3 and they can check the key. Remind them no phones. If students do not seem to be working, give 2 general warnings. If students will not work by the third time, dismantle the groups and require students to work alone.
